What is 1Password?

1Password is a password manager which can be downloaded to ALL computers and mobile devices. That's right, Apple users, Android users, tablet users, iPad and iPhones users can take advantage of 1Password.

You probably already know you should have a different and difficult password for every account. But who can remember all that? To solve that problem, many people use the same password for all or most of their accounts. A hacker would LOVE you for making his job easier! Once s/he has your favorite password, s/he can easily get into all your accounts. Some people write down their passwords and then lose the paper, forget to update the paper or can't read their updates.

1Password encrypts and saves all your passwords so you only need to remember one password. It allows you to create a unique password for every account, making your accounts too difficult and not worth the effort it would take for someone to hack into them.

1Password also allows you to safely store more than passwords. You can also save information regarding your license(s), passport(s), credit cards, social security number(s) and even create secure notes.

Is it safe?

Safety is emotional, not rational. Nothing is 100% safe. But on the continuum of safe AND convenient, this is at the top of the list. I've been using it for almost 10 years and it just keeps getting better and more useful.

Do I need a Mac or Apple Product?

No. 1Password works on any computer and it can also be used across devices including mobile devices. EVERYONE who uses any computer, an iPhone, iPad or an Android can join this class.

How do I get 1Password?

For Apple users, you can get the it from the App Store. But everyone, including Apple users, can go to 1Password.com and download the application directly from their website.

How much does it cost?

As of 2018, you need to purchase a subscription. When you first download the App, you can use it for free for one month. This is helpful since you are taking no risk to give it a try. After one month, you need to purchase the subscription to continue to use it. It costs about \$35/year for a one person subscription and about \$60/year for a family subscription.

Is it difficult to use?

Absolutely not! In fact, once you are introduced to the features, you will find accessing your accounts and other sensitive information easier than having it in a file cabinet.

What is the cost of the class and how do I sign up?

What will I need for the class?

1. Computer or mobile device and download the 1Password App to that device. When you set up your new App, be SURE to create a very difficult one password. Don't use a real word or even part of a word. There's an example of one way to create a difficult password below.
2. Bring all your user names and current passwords for all your accounts.
3. Bring your driver's license.
4. Bring your Social Security Number.
5. Bring your credit cards.

Will you offer some technical assistance for the initial set up?

Yes. If you find you have difficulty downloading 1Password or are uneasy about even trying, come early. I will be at the church by noon to offer 1:1 help.
